


Figure: Computer Simulation of Pyramidal Neurons




Figure: Gödel, Escher, Bach by Douglas Hofstadter




Figure: Thomas Nagel (1937-)




Figure: Paper by Computational Neurobiologist Terrence Sejnowski, January, 2020
