


Use governs possession. What about labor, then?

 the top 737 out of 37 million individuals and multinational corporations in 194 countries exercise 80% control



 - 2) ability to leverage media platforms





New life forms, artificial intelligence


- having body, emotion, thought, will, consciousness, just like human beings

- do business, accumulate wealth, buy equipment, hire humans and other robots












Artificial Intelligence's market participation rate increases




Platform Worker

The average citizen becomes a platform worker


platform worker = freelancer = precariat (precarious proletariat)
- Guy Standing

- full-time/retirement security will be replaced by -> contractor/freelancer
- an absolute majority of citizens turn to unstable workers through platforms
- on the surface, freedom of participation, but a life subordinate to a platforms
- mainly composed of current workers, small business owners, and professionals
- dynamically changes participation rates in the market as AI changes
