






Korea's population is ageing, threatening economic growth












Adoption of Al in Korea remains low

% of SMEs reporting usage of generative AI or other forms of AI








To encourage adoption, Al should be safe and trustworthy

% of firms reporting the existence of guidelines, by sector and firm size






Social dialogue can facilitate the Al transition

% of employees saying employers consult unions or councils on Al adoption, by firm size








Investing in skills will be critical to make a success of Al


The most reported barrier among Korean SMEs is a lack of skills among employees

% of SMEs reporting whether generative AI has made the skill more important or less important








Less than half of firms in Korea say they have provided training for workers to work with Al

% of firms reporting providing training programs to employees






Special support should be provided to SMEs


SMEs in Korea are positive about the impact of generative Al

Across the OECD, there is little evidence that Al is reducing employment overall








The vast majority of firms in Korea say that Al only replaces up to 10% of tasks

% of firms reporting that AI replaces 0%, 10% or fewer, 11-30% and 31-50% of tasks





What can policymakers do?

- Invest in training
- Promote social dialogue
- Provide social protection and employment services
- Support an inclusive transition
- Ensure that AI is safe and trustworthy
